

Sensory Guide for *Furlough's Paradise*

Play Summary

Two cousins reunite carrying grief, distance, and unspoken truths. With time running out before **Sade** must return to prison, they confront memory's fragility and the weight of their shared past. In the tension between loss and hope, they imagine a future they must build together.

There is no intermission.

Moments to be aware of:

- This production includes **swearing** and **racially charged language**. It also includes discussions about **death** and **grieving, anti-Black racism, and imprisonment**.
- This production contains the use of **bright lights, loud sounds, and haze**.
- A woman in distress and a costume **covering an actors face** in a dream sequence
- Loud **thunder**
